

The following infractions have been assigned various point values. Staff members will carefully issue disciplinary points for students misbehaving and submit the form to the principal for approval. The form will then be mailed home.

The following infractions will incur a **one-hour detention** with the principal in addition to points:

The following infractions will incur a **one day in-school suspension** and a **required parent conference** with the principal:

The following infractions will incur a **minimum of one-day out of school suspension, probation, and a required parent-principal conference:**

Between 5 to 30 disciplinary points and detention or suspension will be assigned based on the nature or extent of the misbehavior(s):

Accrual of points will result in the following consequences:

LEVEL ONE

- 1-4 Points** Administrator or designee may call parent.
- 5-9 Points** Administrator will meet with student, call parent(s). One hour detention to be served with principal. Parents must provide transportation.
- 10-19 Points** One day in-school suspension. Conference with parent, student and administrator. Student will lose privileges to participate in or attend intramurals, interscholastic or school activities for one week (e.g., sports, Student Council, dance). The student will be placed on a program of behavior monitoring for a period of two weeks.

LEVEL TWO

- 20 Points** Two (2) days in-school suspension. Administrator will meet with student and parent. The student will participate in a daily behavior monitoring program for a period of time determined by the administration. The student will lose privileges to participate in or attend all extracurricular or school activities for a period to be determined by the administration.

LEVEL THREE

- 30 Points** Out of school suspension and Child Study Team involvement. Parents must attend meeting with an administrator and the CST to have their student re-enter school.

POINT REDUCTION:

Proper behavior is expected and rewarded. Students will lose 5 points for each calendar month without an infraction. Students are also encouraged to take a positive role in their own behavior modification. Student initiated point-reduction plans are possible with administrative approval.

Please also be aware that any and all discipline procedures may be used for extra-curricular activities such as sports, clubs, assemblies and field trips.
